#### Jonah

- Jonah was a historical figure, and lived in the times of Jereboam II (about 750 BC)
- \* 2 Kings 14:25 "[Jereboam] was the one who restored the boundaries of Israel from Lebo Hamath to the Dead Sea, in accordance with the word of the Lord, the God of Israel, spoken through his servant Jonah son of Amittai, the prophet from Gath Hepher."

#### The word of the LORD

- > The Word of the LORD is Jesus (the Lord who saves)
- Jonah => "dove"
- "The dove came to him toward evening, and behold, in her beak was a freshly picked olive leaf. So Noah knew that the water was abated from the earth."

"Arise, go to Nineveh the great city and cry against it, for their wickedness has come up before Me."

Jonah 1:2

#### Nineveh

- One of the largest cities in the world
- > 120,000 inhabitants
- > Capital city of the Assyrian empire

## The wickedness of Nineveh

"Assyria swept through the Middle-East. They laid cities to waste, tortured the survivors, and spread terror everywhere they went. This was the first nation to torment its enemies with psychological warfare."

"But Jonah rose up to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the LORD."

Jonah 1:3

#### Tarshish

- For [Solomon] had at sea the ships of Tarshish with the ships of Hiram; once every three years the ships of Tarshish came bringing gold and silver, ivory and apes and peacocks."
- Associated with trade, expensive metals, and exotic animals

"So he went down to Joppa, found a ship which was going to Tarshish, paid the fare and went down into it to go with them to Tarshish from the presence of the LORD."

# What did Jesus say about Jonah?

- > Matt 12:39-40
- > Matt 16:4
- > Luke 11:29-42

#### Matt 16:1-4

The Pharisees and Sadducees came up, and testing Jesus, they asked Him to show them a sign from heaven. 2 But He replied to them, ... 4 "An evil and adulterous generation seeks after a sign; and a sign will not be given it, except the sign of Jonah."

## Luke 11:29-32

29 As the crowds were increasing, He began to say, "This generation is a wicked generation; it seeks for a sign, and [yet] no sign will be given to it but the sign of Jonah. 30 For just as Jonah became a sign to the Ninevites, so will the Son of Man be to this generation. ... 32 The men of Nineveh will stand up with this generation at the judgment and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah;

#### Matt 12:38-40

> 38 Then some of the scribes and Pharisees said to Him, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You." 39 But He answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation craves for a sign; and [yet] no sign will be given to it but the sign of Jonah the prophet; 40 for just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the sea monster, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

### The sign of Jonah

- > Proof that salvation comes from God
- > Points the way for salvation
- > The sign itself was a story of salvation

#### 25/10/16
