WHO IS OUR ENEMY?

THE DEVIL is our direct enemy

THE WORLD an indirect enemy

(1 John 5:19) we know that we are children of God, and that the whole world is under the control of the evil one.

(Ephesians 6:12) for our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

(1 John 3:8) the reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.

(1 Tim 1:13-14) I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent man, I was shown mercy because I acted in ignorance and unbelief. The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus

(John 8:12) I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.

(Colossians 1:13-14) (God) has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

(Ephesians 2:8) it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.

(1 John 5:3-5) everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God

(Matthew 5:14-17) You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. (John 1:5) the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.
