



**Jesus called a little child to him

Kingdom of Heaven.**



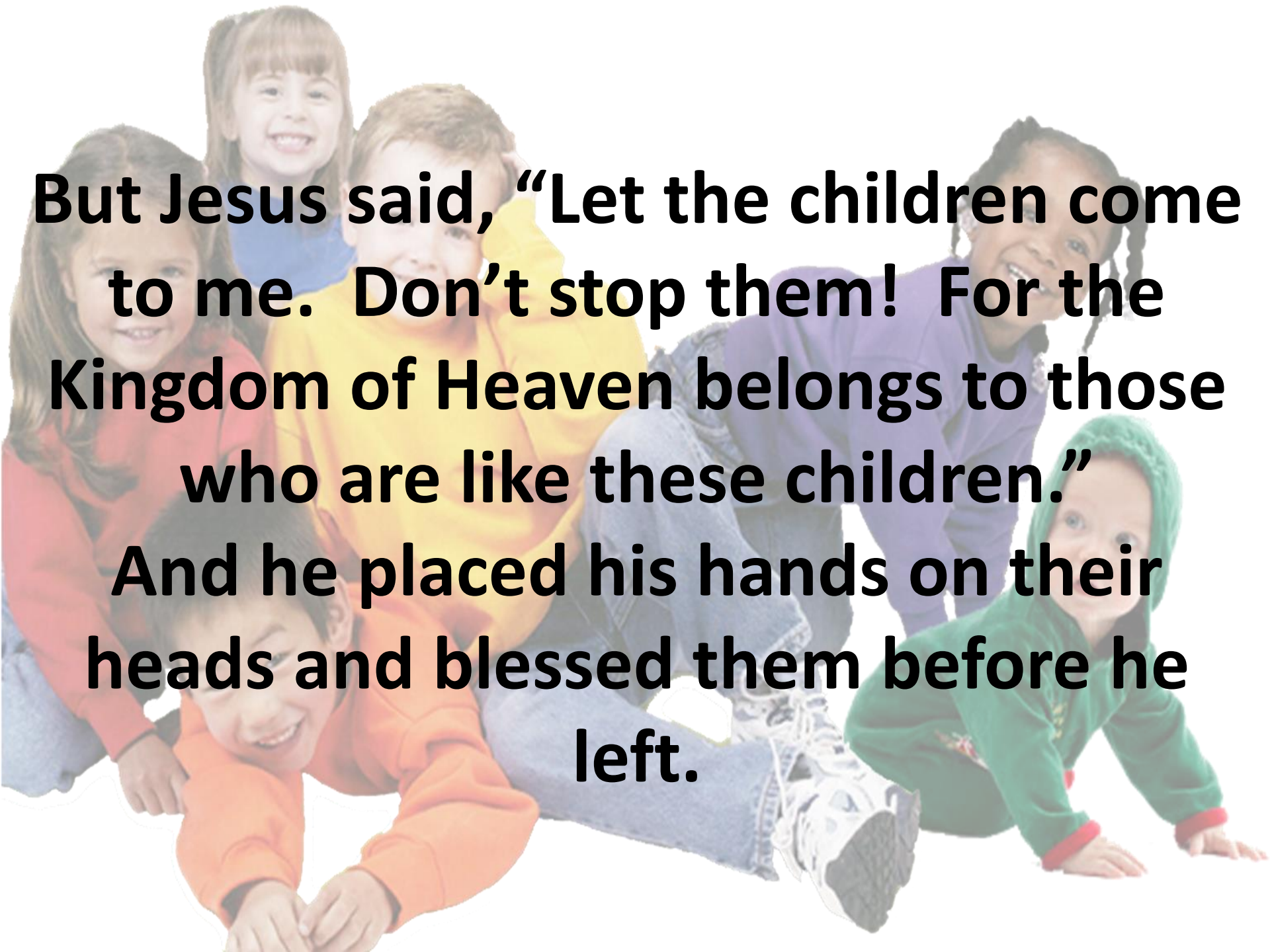
